Frequently Asked Questions

Where did the money to purchase Niko's Landing come from?

The money was received by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and not taken from the general fund populated by taxpayer money. Taxes will not be raised for the new facility.

Why did the township become interested in creating this new facility?

The township's long-term plan was to build or buy a new facility to ensure continued growth for the township. However, the opportunity was presented to purchase Niko's Landing.

Why did we decide on Niko's Landing?

After looking at the possibility of building a new building, it was more affordable to purchase the Niko's Landing facility.

When did we start using our current hall?

1967, it's served us for 55 years!

What's the next step for Niko's Landing?

After closing on the building in early April, the Comstock Township Board will choose an architectural firm to come up with a design, then we'll begin remodeling.

When can the public expect the township hall to be open as the new township hall?

Projected in 2023


Next Step:

The township is planning on closing on the Niko's Landing property in the first few weeks of April.

The Township Board approved the purchase of Niko's Landing on January 20th for \$975,000. That is paid for in ARPA funds.

We're gearing up for the May 3rd Special Election. Absent Voter (AV) ballots have been mailed to those who have returned a signed application for this election. If you're interested in voting absentee, you can submit an application online or via mail to be received by Friday, April 29th at 5:00pm and in-person until 4:00pm on Monday, May 2nd. A voter who requests a ballot in-person after April 29th must vote the ballot in the office.

Over \$30 million in property taxes were collected by the Treasurer's office and paid out to the appropriate taxing entities for the 2021 tax year. I'm proud to report that everything balanced and was settled with the County Treasurer on March 7th, 2022. I will start to receive the information I need to create the 2022 tax database in mid to late May. In preparation for the new tax year, I will be ordering tax bill supplies, setting up all my collection reports and spreadsheets for 2022, and attending some professional development.

Special assessment notices will be mailed out on April 25th and payments are due by August 1st, 2022. As a reminder, any special assessment amounts not paid by November 1st, 2022, will be added to the winter tax bill.
