We're pleased to announce that Spring Curbside Pickup will begin on Monday, April 29, 2024. Curbside Pickup is only for residents that live within Comstock Township's limits. All items must be put out on Saturday, April 27th or Sunday, April 28th. Any items not put out by then will not be picked up.

We hope pickup will be completed within 2 weeks, but pickup will go until crews have reached each street once.

Crews WILL NOT return to areas for items placed after April 28th.

Please go online for more details and for a list of items we can and cannot accept for curbside pickup. As a general rule, we cannot accept anything that two people cannot safely pick up and put into a truck.

Deadline reminders:

- Friday, November 3rd is the last day to submit a written request to spoil an absentee ballot and have a new one mailed to you.
- Saturday, November 4th Clerk's office is open 8 am 4 pm to register voters and issue absentee ballots.
- Monday, November 6th Last day to submit a written request to spoil an absentee ballot and have a new one issued to you in the Clerk's office.
- Tuesday, November 7th Election Day! Voters may vote in the polls 7:00am 8:00pm. Absentee ballots can be issued only to those registering to vote on election day.



Winter property tax bills will be mailed out by December 1, 2023, and tax amounts become due and payable on that date. To avoid a 3% penalty, payments must be received by 5:00 p.m. on February 14, 2024. Payments can be made by mail, in-person at the Township office, by using the drive-up drop box located at the east end of the parking lot, or online at <a href="www.comstockmi.gov">www.comstockmi.gov</a>. We accept cash, check, money order, electronic check (\$3 fee), and major credit cards (3% fee). When paying online, we also accept PayPal, Venmo, Google Pay, and Apple Pay (3% fee for each). Any payments not received by February 29, 2024, will be turned over as delinquent to the Kalamazoo County Treasurer.



Assistant Chief Kevin Thompson graduated from Eastern Michigan University School of Fire Staff and Command on October 20, 2023. This executive leadership program consisted of 360 hours of Master's level classroom instruction that required out-of-class study, papers, projects, and examination preparation. This program was completed one week a month from February through October. EMU's Fire Staff and Command School is recognized as one of the nation's most challenging and rewarding Chief Fire Officer management programs. Congratulations Assistant Chief Thompson.

Assistant Chief Thompson's project was on the "Feasibility of providing Basic Life Support to Comstock Township". This project researched the need for Comstock Fire & Rescue to provide a higher level of EMS care to the community, and also the feasibility of doing so.

In preparation for Veteran's Day we will be walking through both cemeteries and replacing flags at the graves of Veterans. If you know of a Veteran whose flag has blown away or been damaged, please let us know! We have been updating our Master List of veterans. If you have discovered a member of the military in our cemeteries has not received a flag or a military grave marker, please contact us so we can place those remembrances at their graves. These include Grand Army of the Republic (1861- 1865), Civil War, U.S. Veteran, World War I, World War II, Korean War, Vietnam Service, and Vietnam Veteran markers.

#### Plot designation

As a reminder, if you have multiple plots in one of our cemeteries, consider designating each plot or adding a co-owner. If the lot owner dies and plots are unassigned, a will or a probate court order would be required to allow heirs to use the remaining plots.




