

Comstock is a Charter Township, which consists of seven elected positions: one Supervisor, one Clerk, one Treasurer, and four Trustees, all whom must live in the Township to qualify to hold office. Each office is a four-year term beginning on November 20 at 12:00 noon and each official must take an oath of office prior to serving. Each elected position holds equal voting authority to the others. Each board member is required to vote on all items, unless there is a conflict of interest or a legal reason for abstaining.

Supervisor

- Serves as the moderator of all Township Board meetings and regulates the proceedings (including granting authority to speak, making a declaration of votes cast, and maintaining order)
- Acts as the secretary to the Board of Review and must keep a record of the proceedings, including all changes made to the assessment roll.
 - Must file these with the Township Clerk
- Acts as the Township's legal agent
- Maintains the records of the Supervisor's office
- Recommends appointments for some boards and commissions
- May call special meetings
- May appoint a deputy
- May administer oath of office
- May not serve on the Planning Commission

*All Charter Township statutory duties of the Township Supervisor (MCL 42.10 (a) through (o)) were delegated to the Township Superintendent by Board resolution on November 12, 2016.
