

Comstock Township Curbside Pickup 2026



Dates and Policies

- Fall Curbside Pickup begins May 11th 2026
- Clean-up is ONLY for residents who live within Comstock Township's limits.
- All items must be out to your curb on May 9th or May 10th.
 - Pickup should be complete within 2 weeks but will continue until crews have reached each street once
- Crews WILL NOT return to areas for items placed after specified dates.

Accepted Items

- Limit 4 cubic yards
- All loose items MUST be in boxes
- Items must be no bigger than what two people can safely pick up and place in a truck
- Household doors and windows
- Furniture
- Carpet
- Toys
- Misc. rubbish/junk
- Packaging
- Glass-MUST be in a cardboard box or sturdy container, taped shut
- Mattresses/box springs-MUST be wrapped in plastic

Items NOT Accepted

- Hot tubs
- Cut up boats
- Concrete, blocks, bricks
- Freon appliances such as refrigerators, freezers and a/c units
- Dehumidifiers
- Electronics-including computers, printers, monitors, and accessories
- Televisions
- Bathtubs: iron, steel or cast iron
- Medical waste
- Batteries
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Auto parts or engines
- Tires
- Chemicals-paints, solvents, pesticides, herbicides
- Oil
- Gasoline
- Antifreeze
- Other household hazardous waste

Consumers Concrete and the Kalamazoo County Hazardous Waste Center can handle the disposal of some of these items.
